Day 03

• Jankichatti To Uttarkashi/Netala 150Km Drive(8-9 hrs) Overnight Stay.

Day 04

• Uttarkashi/Netala To Gangotri TempleAfter Darsan Return To Uttarkashi. 200Km Both Side 10Hrs.

Day 05

• Uttarkashi/Netala To Guptkashi/Sonprayag 270km Time Taken 10 to 11 Hrs

Day 06

• Drive 270 km Guptkashi/Sonprayag To Kedarnath Trek 19kKm From Gaurikund Overnight stay In Kedarnath.

Day 07

• Trek 19 km Back Kedarnath To Gaurikund, Drive 5 km to Sonprayag, OvernightStay Same.

Day 08

• Guptkashi/Sonprayag To Badrinath Drive 240 km (8-9 hrs), visit Mana Village (3 km from Badrinath), stay overnight.

Day 09

• Badrinath To Mana Village (3 km from Badrinath) And Drive Haridwar/Rishikesh (10-11 hrs), Trip Ends.



Haridwar To Janki Chatti

- This morning, as per the arrival schedule, a
 Triponhimalaya representative or driver will meet
 us at the designated location. Once we board our
 vehicle, we will begin our journey to Barkot or Janki
 Chatti
- Our route follows the well-known Rajpur Road in Dehradun, passing the old Shiva Temple before heading through Mussoorie. We will drive over the beautiful Mussoorie mountains and past the famous Kempty Falls. Along the way, there are several great restaurants where we can stop for brunch or lunch (to be paid directly).
- After our meal, we will continue toward Janki Chatti. Upon arrival, we will check into our prebooked hotel or guesthouse. The rest of the evening is free for leisure and relaxation

Janki Chatti To Yamunotri

- This morning, after an early breakfast, we will start our 6 km trek to Yamunotri. Horse and doli services are available at an extra cost.
- At Yamunotri, we will visit the temple, take a dip in the hot springs at Surya Kund, and participate in the pooja ceremony to seek blessings from Yamunaji.
- Afterward, we will retrace our steps back to Janki Chatti. The return journey allows us to enjoy the scenic views once more.
- On arrival, we will check into our guest house for a restful evening. You can relax, reflect on the spiritual experience of the day, or take a short walk around the area.
- We will stay overnight at the guest house in Janki Chatti, preparing for the next day's journey

- The total journey is around 200 km and takes about 9 to 10 hours.



Uttarkashi/Netala To Guptkashi/Sonprayag 270Km


- Day 5: Drive to Sonprayag, the next stop for the Kedarnath and Badrinath Dham trip.
- The drive covers 230 km with beautiful views of Himalayan forests and villages with terrace farming.
- Sonprayag, located at 1829 meters, is believed to be the place where Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati got married.
- After the drive, head to Phata for an overnight stay.
- Take time to rest after the long journey as the next day we continue to Kedarnath Dham.


Guptkashi/Sonprayag To Kedarnath 19Km 7Hrs

- On the second day, we will travel to Kedarnath via Sonprayag and Gaurikund. Breakfast will be on the way. You'll take a jeep to reach Gaurikund, a sacred lake where Mata Parvati bathed, and a temple was built in her honor.
- From Sonprayag, it's a 5-6 km drive to Gaurikund, where the challenging 18 km uphill trek to Kedarnath begins, following the Mandakini River.
- Kedarnath Temple is home to idols of Pandavas, Draupadi, and Sage Adi Shankaracharya. In the temple, there is a Shivling, one of the 12 Jyotirlingas. The temple is surrounded by peaks: Kedar Kund (22,000 feet), Kharchkund (21,600 feet), and Bharatkund (22,000 feet).
- After visiting the temple, you can rest at a hotel in Kedarnath and enjoy a peaceful dinner.





Distance: 20km Time-Taker 9 to 11 Hr









Kedarnath To Sonprayag/Guptkashi (19 Km Trek 35 km Drive)

- This morning, visit the Kedarnath Temple again. Afterwards, begin the trek down to Gaurikund. Once you reach Gaurikund, drive back to Sonprayag.
- Upon arrival at Sonprayag, check into the hotel, relax, and enjoy the evening. Stay overnight at the hotel.


Sonprayag/Guptkashi To Badrinath (200 km Drive / 10 Hrs)

- On the next morning, get ready for your second Dham visit to Badrinath. After packing your bags and having breakfast, the drive will begin. Your hotel rooms will be located in front of the temple, offering a view of the Maha Pooja Abhishek. You can freshen up and then visit the temple for worship.
- Badrinath, dedicated to Lord Vishnu, is located at 3133 meters above sea level. The temple is an important part of the Char Dham Yatra. It is said that Lord Vishnu meditated here, and Mata Lakshmi took the form of a badri tree to protect him from storms.
- Other attractions include the Triyuginarayan Temple, Taptkund (hot spring), and Naradkund. On the way, visit Bheempul, a stone bridge built by Bhima to help Draupadi.
- Finally, explore Mana Village, the last village of India, and visit the Vyas Cave and Ganesh Cave. Return to the hotel for dinner and rest.









Badrinath To Haridwar/Rishikesh (320 Km Drive 10 hrs)

- Today, after breakfast, we will visit the first Indian village, Mana, located at the India-Tibet border. Mana is a beautiful village, that attracts tourists from all over the world. The locals, known as Bhotias (Mongol Tribes), live in small, beautifully decorated cottages. The village is famous for its woollen items, which you can buy as souvenirs. The scenic beauty of this village is truly mesmerizing.
- After visiting Mana, we will continue our drive to Badrinath. Upon arrival, check into the hotel. Later, explore the Badrinath Dham and, if you wish, take a bath at the Tapt Kund (hot spring).
- In the evening, attend the Aarti ceremony at the Badrinath Temple and have a darshan of Badrivishal.
- The next day, after breakfast, we will participate in the morning Aarti ceremony and then drive straight to Rishikesh, arriving in the evening. Make your onward travel reservations accordingly.




